The Union Aid Society has been a “safety-net” for the Quaker Valley community for over one hundred years. Quietly and compassionately we help seniors, families, single parents and children – **any neighbor in need** – when emergencies or hardships occur.

In 1898, a group of caring women from area churches united to help their neighbors in need. The non-profit organization they established, **The Union Aid Society** relies on the generous support from our community to assist those requiring help within the Quaker Valley School District.

The Union Aid Society has become a lifeline for residents of the Quaker Valley needing help with:

- Food • Housing Costs • Clothing • Medical Needs
- Utilities • Child Care

In addition, The Union Aid Society also owns and subsidizes apartments for low income seniors, and awards a college



scholarship to a qualifying senior living in the Quaker Valley school district.

The executive director, a licensed social worker, works with people in a crisis situation to get them immediate help or refers them to other agencies to meet their specific needs.

The Union Aid Society works with many community organizations, local schools and houses of worship.

Along with our partners, we coordinate several annual community programs including a Thanksgiving Food Program, a Children’s Holiday Gift Program, and Back-to-School Program.
